New Internal Sounder

RISCO Group is pleased to announce the release of the new wireless internal sounder in a contemporary round design. The sounder is compatible with RISCO Group's Agility and WisDom Wireless Security Systems and its functionality is identical to the previous internal wireless sounder.

The Internal Sounder is fully wireless requiring no AC power. These sounders include a pre-alarm feature that begins at entry delay countdown and sends an alarm if RISCO Group's wireless systems are vandalized during entry delay. Battery life economy is ensured through an advanced algorithm, and a low battery signal is included for both transceiver and sounder.



Features include:

- Two-way wireless, fully battery powered sounder
- 105dBa piezo sound output, adjustable volume
- Cover and back tamper
- Includes 5 long-life 3V lithium batteries for 3 year typical battery life

NEW NovaGardGA Bell Box

Non Grade 3 Mode

The new NovagardGA bell box (with DIP switches instead of Jumpers) has a new feature of 'bell trigger monitoring' in order to comply with EN50131-4 standard for Grade 3. This feature monitors the bell trigger connection (S-) by means of measuring the screw terminal voltage. If this screw terminal voltage falls below 2V or rises above 9V, the bell will be activated.

SynopSYS Case Study

Lincolnshire County Council required a flexible system solution for their 48 office complex which are sublet to different companies. Leading security company R.J. Coleman contacted RISCO Group to assist them in providing a high-end integrated system solution for the project.
