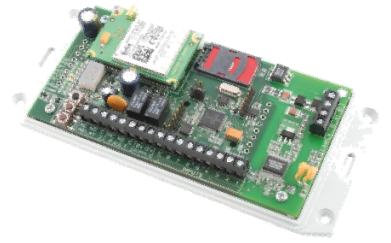
Bus detection

Up to 32 Indoor and Outdoor Bus detectors can be installed on the ProSYS Bus without the need for physical zone expanders. Each Bus detector has an extra built-in relay zone so you can wire a conventional device to the Bus detector. The conventional device is then assigned to any zone number in the panel and terminated as NC, NO, EOL, DEOL and reports events over the Bus with dedicated zone code.
